

Admissions Statement for Children with Special Educational Needs

Admission to Martinshaw will not be refused because of a belief that the school cannot educate or support a child's special educational needs. All Governing Bodies are required by section 324 of the Education Act 1996 to admit a child with a Statement of Special Educational Needs or an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHC Plan) if the documentation names the school.

Pupils with special educational needs (but not Statement or EHC Plan) follow the routes outlined in the LA Admissions Policy. Martinshaw Primary School will not refuse to admit a pupil because (s)he does not have a Statement or EHC Plan or is being assessed for one.
